 - Breakfast – Each student will receive \$5 for fast food restaurant (bring extra if needed)
 - Lunch – Each student will receive \$5 for fast food restaurant (bring extra if needed)
 - Supper – We will only stop for supper if there is a travel delay. Plan on eating supper after arriving back in Van
- Money Needed:
 - \$10-\$20 for extra supper and snacks at stops
- 7:00 p.m. – Arrive at Van High School

Please note that all times are approximate and may change depending on various travel concerns

General Information

What goes under the bus?

- Your instrument
- Band Uniform; Twirling Uniform
- One suitcase per person (this will be stored under the bus without access while traveling overnight to and from Orlando)

What can I bring on the bus?

- Small carry-on bag containing the following:
 - Deodorant (not aerosol spray), contact lens solution, tooth brush/paste, and other toiletries that you may need for overnight bus travel
 - Please do not spray or use any cologne, perfume, or strong-smelling lotion/hand sanitizers while on the bus. Strong scents in an enclosed bus can be very overwhelming
 - Barf bag if you easily get car sick
 - Playing cards, games, etc.
 - Personal electronics with headphones. Any movies watched on personal electronic devices are subject to chaperone review. Any inappropriate movies or pictures being viewed will result in immediate confiscation of that device for the remainder of the trip
 - Snacks...please exercise moderation. We will make stops along the way where you can buy more snacks
 - Bottled water, sports drink, or soft drink with a SCREW ON LID ONLY. No glass containers, cans, or fountain drinks will be allowed on the bus
- Pillow and blanket or light jacket for sleeping
- Medicine
 - All prescription medication must be checked in by Thursday, March 5th by 8:00 a.m. (If possible, bring on the afternoon of Wednesday, March 4th) The Band director or Chaperone in charge of medication will administer medication as needed. Please include detailed instructions with the medications
 - No student is allowed to keep prescription medication in their possession or in their luggage with the exception of asthma inhalers
 - Medicine will be kept secure and will be administered in a confidential manner
- Movies for watching on the bus while traveling must be approved as appropriate by the band directors

What NOT to pack?

- Anything of value that you cannot live without
- Contraband – illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco, vaping products, weapons, et....
- Selfish attitude, bad mood, hyper activity, inconsideration and irresponsibility

What do I wear?

- See the itinerary for specifics about what to wear each day of the trip
- All clothing must meet VHS dress code requirements. Students will be asked to change out of any inappropriate clothing. Pajama pants are acceptable for the bus ride as long as you cannot see through them and they cover you completely
- We will be doing A LOT of walking while in Orlando. Bring comfortable shoes...flip flops will not last you through this trip!
- Dress clothes will not be required at any point so you may wear comfortable clothes at all times
- The weather in Orlando is very similar to the weather in Texas during Spring Break. We could see temperatures in the 80-degree range or there could be a cold front. Please look at the weather forecast as we draw near to our departure time so that you can pack appropriately
- When waking up on the bus...
 - We will sleep on the bus Thursday night, March 5th and Tuesday night, March 10th. If you would like a fresh shirt to wear when you wake up, please pack it in your carry-on bag. You will have an opportunity to freshen up at a truck stop

Ticket and Fast Pass Information

Disney has a service called FastPass+ included with the price of admission at each park. FastPass+ makes it possible to skip longer lines, giving you more time to enjoy the park. To use FastPass+ you must have your park ticket information. Students will receive their Disney ticket information as soon as it is available so that they may begin to reserve times. Universal charges an additional fee for fast pass services that the Van Band will not be providing

Money and Meals

- Please see the itinerary for a description of the spending money needed each day as well as a list of meals and how they are paid for. A meal at each of the parks that we are visiting costs between \$10-\$20 depending on where you choose to eat and how much you eat
- Disney and Universal theme parks allow patrons to bring snacks and water in with them from outside of the park. Planning ahead to bring snacks along with you can save you a lot of money while in the park. Please use the internet to search for specifications regarding what type of outside snacks are allowed in each park
- There is no set amount for spending money. I recommend at least \$50-\$100 for souvenirs. Be smart and don't buy souvenirs with meal money!!

Tips for good money management

- Consider placing the money for each day in envelopes labeled by date so as not to overspend early on in the trip
- If using a credit or debit card, have a plan of action in place in case a card is lost or stolen
- Parents should go over strategies for safeguarding money such as carrying wallets in front pockets or in secure purses/fanny packs. Don't assume that your money can't or won't be stolen

Student Expectations

On the bus

- Follow the instructions of the bus driver, band director, or adult chaperones at all times. When an adult is speaking, total silence is expected
- Stay seated while the bus is in motion unless you are headed to the bus restroom or need something specific from an adult
- Use conversation voices only. No loud outbursts!
- Eating and drinking on the bus is a privilege. Students should police their area and keep it clean at all times. No glass containers, canned drinks, or fountain drinks are allowed on the bus
- No public displays of affections will be allowed on the bus. This includes couples laying on each other in their seats. You will be asked to separate if necessary
- Never exit the bus unless an adult instructs you to do so
- Do not run or horse play at any stops along the way
- Each chaperone will be assigned a group of students to check on constantly. Chaperones are our guests. They are here to help us. You should act in a positive, respectful, and polite manner to chaperones at all times

At the Hotel

- Boys are not allowed to enter girls' rooms and girls are not allowed to enter boys' rooms
- No one outside of our group is allowed to enter any student room and vice versa
- Curfew means to be in your room and to remain there with the door closed until the appointed time. If there is a problem, contact your chaperone by phone....do not leave your room! We will have a paid security guard on duty to monitor for students being out of their room after curfew
- Do not walk around the hotel alone
- Do not leave the hotel for any reason unless we are all leaving together
- A full breakfast is provided at the hotel at no additional charge. Everyone must eat something! We will be doing a lot of walking and you will need your nourishment

In Orlando

- Stay in your group at all times. NEVER stray away from the group or walk alone
- Be on time to all meeting spots (To be early, is to be on time)
- You are no longer just under VISD guidelines for behavior....there are theme park rules as well as city and state laws in effect....watch what you say and how you act
- Exiting and entering the bus in an efficient way is very important. Please be ready in advance of each stop

Discipline Management Plan

- In the event that any illegal activities take place involving assault, alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, shoplifting, etc., the necessary authorities may be contacted and/or a student may be sent home early from the trip at their parents' expense
- I fully expect that we will have no discipline problems on this trip

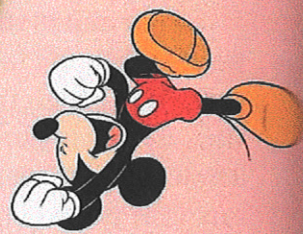
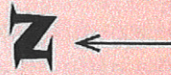

WALT DISNEY WORLD®

In order to enjoy Disney World to the fullest, here are some traveling tips on what to see, where to eat, and how to get around the Magic Kingdom and EPCOT Center. All theme parks are HUGE and require a lot of walking and sometimes a lot of waiting in line. By doing some advance planning, much of the standing in line time can be reduced and some of the better attractions will not be missed. **Each park will have an exciting fireworks and laser show with outstanding music to go along with the fireworks at the end of the day.**

Guests entering all Disney theme parks are subject to a security check. There will be two lines, one with bags and one without. Backpacks, parcels, purses, etc., will be searched by Disney Security personnel before guests are permitted to pass through the turnstiles. As buses enter each Disney park, they are assigned to a specific parking spot that is numbered. Please be aware where the bus is parked when you get off and it will be in the same spot when we get ready to leave.

DISNEY'S FASTPASS

Walt Disney World's *Fastpass* is a service that was designed to allow guest to bypass the traditional standby line and enjoy a number of theme park shows and attractions with little or no wait. It's a virtual queue—one you join by visiting "My Disney Experience" via the Internet (with a computer, tablet, or smartphone). Once you've established an account, you can link your ticket (and those in your party) and access *Fastpass* to book times to visit attractions during a pending visit to the park.

- To make advance *Fastpass* reservations, you must have access to the internet.
- It's possible to reserve a same day *Fastpass* assignment at a park kiosk (which actually offers more options and better flexibility). But using them can be time-consuming, and the chances of getting convenient, same-day access to the most popular attractions are slim. Get there early!
- *Fastpass* lets you experience at least 3 attractions or shows per day without waiting in the usually longer standby line. You may be able to get more same-day assignments at in-park kiosks once the times for your first 3 have been used or the times have expired.

THE MAGIC KINGDOM

The Magic Kingdom is similar to Disneyland in California. It is divided into seven sections or "lands" with Cinderella's Castle like the hub of a wheel at the center of the park. Upon entering the Magic Kingdom, do not spend a lot of time on Main Street. It is mostly shops and you will have time to shop there later. There is a lot to see in the Magic Kingdom, but the following are mainly the rides and attractions that **SHOULD NOT** be missed and are also the most popular so the lines start forming early. Some rides may be operating two lines, do not hesitate to get in the shorter line because both lines have the same rides. For some reason, most people will go to the right which makes the line on the left much shorter. The following attractions are the most popular of all the areas, there are a lot more that are not mentioned. Don't forget about the **FASTPASS**.

When getting off the bus in the bus parking lot, make note of what NUMBER your bus is parked in. This is where you will get back on the bus tonight when we leave. We will walk as a group to the Transportation Center that will take us to the Magic Kingdom. You may board the barges that go across the water or you may ride the Monorail. I enjoy the Monorail myself! Take note because this is how you will get back to the buses when we leave tonight.

MAIN STREET U. S. A.

Stepping onto Main Street U. S. A., is like jumping through a time portal. Welcome to the turn of the century America! Horse-drawn trolleys are the transportation of choice, peppy marching bands underscore the bustle of merry, moving masses, and the tantalizing aroma of fresh-baked cookies constantly perfumes the air. There are a lot of shops to visit here but are crowded as you come into the park. You might want to go to the back and come back here later in the day! The WALT DISNEY WORLD RAILROAD is the first thing you come to. The train circles the park in 20 minutes, making stops in Fantasyland, Frontierland, and Main Street U.S.A. This is really the best orientation of the Magic Kingdom as it passes by most of the parks major lands.

TOMORROWLAND

SPACE MOUNTAIN—Indoor Roller coaster type ride through space (in the dark). The most popular thrill ride. Not for the faint hearted or weak stomachs. (do not ride soon after eating!!) Ride before noon or the hour before the park closes. Lines will be long but they move fast. Don't let long lines keep you from this ride. GO HERE FIRST! TIP: (If you have doubts about riding Space Mountain, take a trip on the TOMORROWLAND TRANSIT AUTHORITY. It travels through the queue area inside Space Mountain and offers a view of the rockets as they hurtle through the darkness.)

BUZZ LIGHTYEAR'S SPACE RANGER SPIN-- The Evil Emperor Zurg is up to no good. As soon as he swipes enough batteries to power his ultimate weapon of destruction--KERPLOOEY!--it's curtains for the toy universe as we know it. It's up to that Space Ranger extra-ordinaire Buzz Lightyear and his Junior Space Rangers (that means you) to save the day.

TOMORROWLAND TRANSIT AUTHORITY: Boarded near Astro Orbiter, these trains (also known as WEDway PeopleMover) move at a speed of about seven minutes per hour along almost a mile of track beside or through most of the attractions in Tomorrowland. The peaceful, breezy, excursion takes about ten minutes. There's rarely a wait to board.

ADVENTURELAND

JUNGLE CRUISE--Cruise the jungle rivers of the world, good special effects and the boat captains make what looks like a boring ride very entertaining.

PIRATES OF THE CARIBBEAN--Cruise along a coastal town that is being plundered by a fun loving group of pirates. Excellent effects, not to be missed. (fast loading) This is one of Disney's most popular rides. This is the attraction that inspired the *Pirates of the Caribbean* movies. "Yo Ho, Yo Ho, a Pirate's Life for Me."

SWISS FAMILY TREE HOUSE—There has never been a more perfect treehouse based on the movie *The Swiss Family Robinson*.

THE ENCHANTED TIKI ROOM (UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT)—A nine minute show that features talking and singing birds!! This was the first Audio-Animatronics attraction ever. The new management is Iago and Zazu from the *Lion King*. Very funny and entertaining.

THE MAGIC CARPETS OF ALADDIN—Welcome to Agrabah! It features 16 magic carpets that fly through the air!

FRONTIERLAND

DIAMOND HORSESHOE SALOON REVUE—Singing cowboys, silly jokes, and a magician—this western dance hall has it all. Each 30-minute show features a madcap mix of melodies and mirth.

COUNTRY BEAR JAMBOREE—The Country Bears may never make it to Broadway, but they don't seem to mind. Disney's brood of banjo-strummin' bruins has been playing to packed houses in Grizzly Hall for more than a quarter century, excellent show to rest and cool off.

BIG THUNDER MOUNTAIN RAILROAD--Roller coaster type ride but not as wild as Space Mountain. Many sights to see on the ride from geysers & flashfloods to bats & tunnel cave ins. (try to ride before noon and again after dark for a totally different look) If you are leary of roller coasters, then this is a good one to try, it is not as scary!!!

SPLASH MOUNTAIN--Disney's "highest, scariest, wildest, and wettest" attraction is a wild ride to contemplate. May have long wait. You probably will get wet on this ride. This is one those rides that you have to ride more than once! Splash Mountain is based on the animated 1946 Disney movie, *Song of the South!*

LIBERTY SQUARE

HAUNTED MANSION--Not as scary as it looks. Excellent special effects, cobwebs and fresh dust are brought in every day. This is great, not to be missed. This is not like an East Texas Spook House!! **THIS IS A REQUIREMENT FOR THE TRIP.**

HALL OF PRESIDENTS--Good place to go in and cool off after a morning of thrill rides. Relax in the theater watching a 20 minute film that is strongly patriotic and inspirational. Followed by a roll call of all 44 Presidents and a talk by President Abraham Lincoln. Best of the Audio-anamatronc (robot) presentations. **REQUIRED ALSO, GREAT HISTORY LESSON.** (Watch for performance times usually a quarter till and a quarter past the hour.)

FANTASYLAND

CINDERELLA'S CASTLE--Just as the amiable mouse named Mickey stands for all the merriment in Walt Disney World, this storybook castle represents the hopes and dreams of childhood, a time in life when anything seems possible. After we march the parade and change out of our uniforms, come to the front of the castle to watch the wonderful exciting show "Wishes"! Wonderful presentation that is projected on the castle and the fireworks show begins after that!

MICKEY'S PHILHARMAGIC—Mickey Mouse and a group of his pals (including Donald, Simba and Ariel) strut their musical stuff to this NEW ear and eye popping production.

OTHER QUIETER CHILDREN'S RIDES ARE: Peter Pan's Flight, Skyway to Tomorrowland, It's a Small World, Dumbo-the Flying Elephant, Mad Tea Party, The Adventures of Winnie the Pooh, Snow White's Adventures and Ariel's Grotto.

FANTASY IN THE SKY: This pyrotechnic extravaganza is presented at the end of the day. It opens with Tinker Bell's Flight over Cinderella's Castle. The seven minute fireworks presentation is ideally viewed from Main Street, but can be seen from just about anywhere.

Please Note: Every Disney park has a fantastic fireworks display at the close of their park. When it is over, that is your cue to go to the buses!!

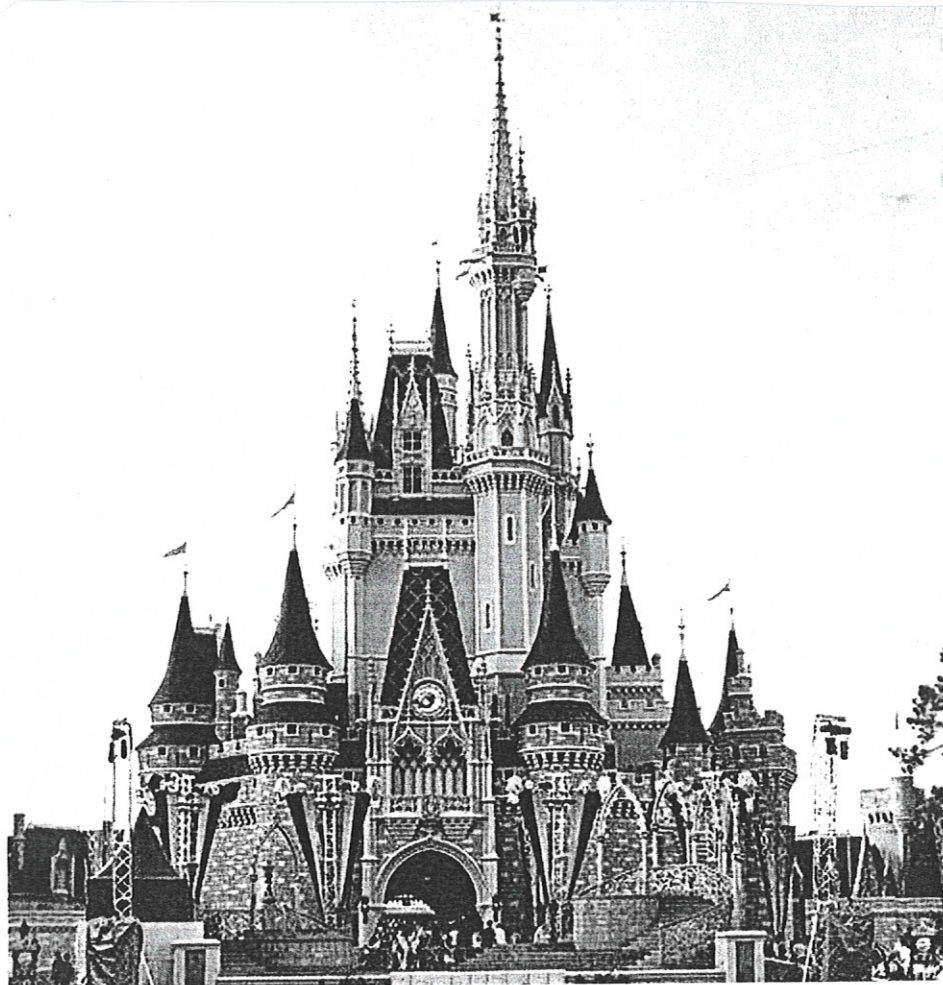
CELEBRATE A DREAM COME TRUE PARADE: "The Main Street Electrical Light Parade" begins at 6:30 p.m. This parade is one of the most popular parades in the world and the **Van Vandal High School Band** will be leading it!! We will **Meet the Guest Coordinator by the Golden Oak Outpost snack stand in Frontierland area of near Pirates and Splash Mountain attractions at 4:45. Do not be late because they will take us "back stage" to our buses so we can dress and get our instruments ready! DO NOT go to bus parking, the buses will move to the backstage area!!!**

HAPPILY EVER AFTER: THE MAGIC KINGDOM'S FIREWORK EXTRAVAGANZA!

"Happily Ever After" a dynamic, pyrotechnic extravaganza, is presented most nights when the Magic Kingdom stays open after dark. Narrated by Jiminy Cricket, this is one of the biggest, boldest, and truly eye-popping *fireworks* show ever presented in the park. Happily is ideally viewed from Main Street, U.S.A., but can be seen from many vantage points. **We will leave the park after this is over.**

EATING IN THE MAGIC KINGDOM

The busiest time for lunch is 11:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. and for dinner 5:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m. There are a number of fast food spots throughout the park. Menus and prices are found outside every eating place so that should help in deciding what you want to eat. **BE SURE YOU CAN USE YOUR MEAL TICKET (\$15.00) WHEREVER YOU EAT!! The Crystal Palace provides cafeteria service in a quiet out of the way location.**

Disney's ANIMAL KINGDOM "The wonders of nature are endless."—Walt Disney

THE OASIS is a thriving tropical garden filled with waterfalls, running streams, and lush vegetation. The Oasis is at once a thriving and calming experience. It sets the stage for what is to come. Making a trip through the Oasis is the only way to get in and out of Animal Kingdom.

DISCOVERY ISLAND

The Tree of Life. A dramatic 145 foot icon of Disney's Animal Kingdom. This "Tree" awakens each night with a lively projection and music show that features stirring visuals, animal spirits, and enchanted fireflies that combine to reveal stories of wander and showcase the magic of nature.

IT'S TOUGH TO BE A BUG! Inside the trunk of the Tree of Life is a 430 seat auditorium featuring an 8 minute, animated 3-D film augmented by some surprising "4-D" effects. The stars of the show are insects.

AFRICA

KILIMANJARO SAFARIS--The 18-minute safari begins with a brief introduction from your guide and driver for the safari. As the vehicle travels along dirt roads, you'll spot free-roaming wild animals, zebras, antelope, hippos, elephants, warthogs, rhinos, lions, and more.

FESTIVAL OF THE LION KING—The talented cast of *The Lion King* performs a high-energy 30 minute stage show in the Harambe Theatre. Presented in the round, this lavish musical revue is as bright and boisterous as the come. Songs include Scar's nasty version of "Be Prepared" as well as "The Circle of Life" and a rousing rendition of "The Lion Sleeps Tonight." **(This is a requirement for the Vandal Band.)**

LET THERE BE LIGHT!—Animal Kingdom's nighttime spectacular known as "Rivers of Light." I would show up early or you might not get a good view.

PANDORA—THE WORLD OF AVATAR

AVATAR FLIGHT OF PASSAGE—The crown jewel of Animal Kingdom takes you on an exuberant trip through Pandora on the back of a flying mountain banshee (aka ikran). This high flying Flight of Passage is a most realistic, immersive experience. It is not recommended for guests with motion sensitivity, heart conditions, fear of heights, claustrophobia, or any other such issues. **You will need to book a FASTPASS+ for this one!**

ASIA

KALI RIVER RAPIDS is an especially soggy experience. It is the rare guest who leaves the ride without a thorough soaking!! Should you wish to repel as much as precipitation as possible, pack a plastic poncho and stash valuables in a nearby locker while you ride. (no charge!!)

UP! AGREAT BIRD ADVENTURE—A 1,000 seat, open air theater, the Caravan Stage features performances by actors wearing nothing but feathers and the occasional crown, plus everyone's favorite Senior Wilderness Explorer Russell and his canine cohort, Dug!!

EXPEDITION EVEREST—The attraction features an old tea train chugging and churning as it climbs up and around snowcapped peaks. Feeling up to the challenge of a dramatic, high-speed, out of control train ride? If you are free of heart, back, and neck problems and are not pregnant, have no fear of heights, or the Abominable Snowman, go for it!!

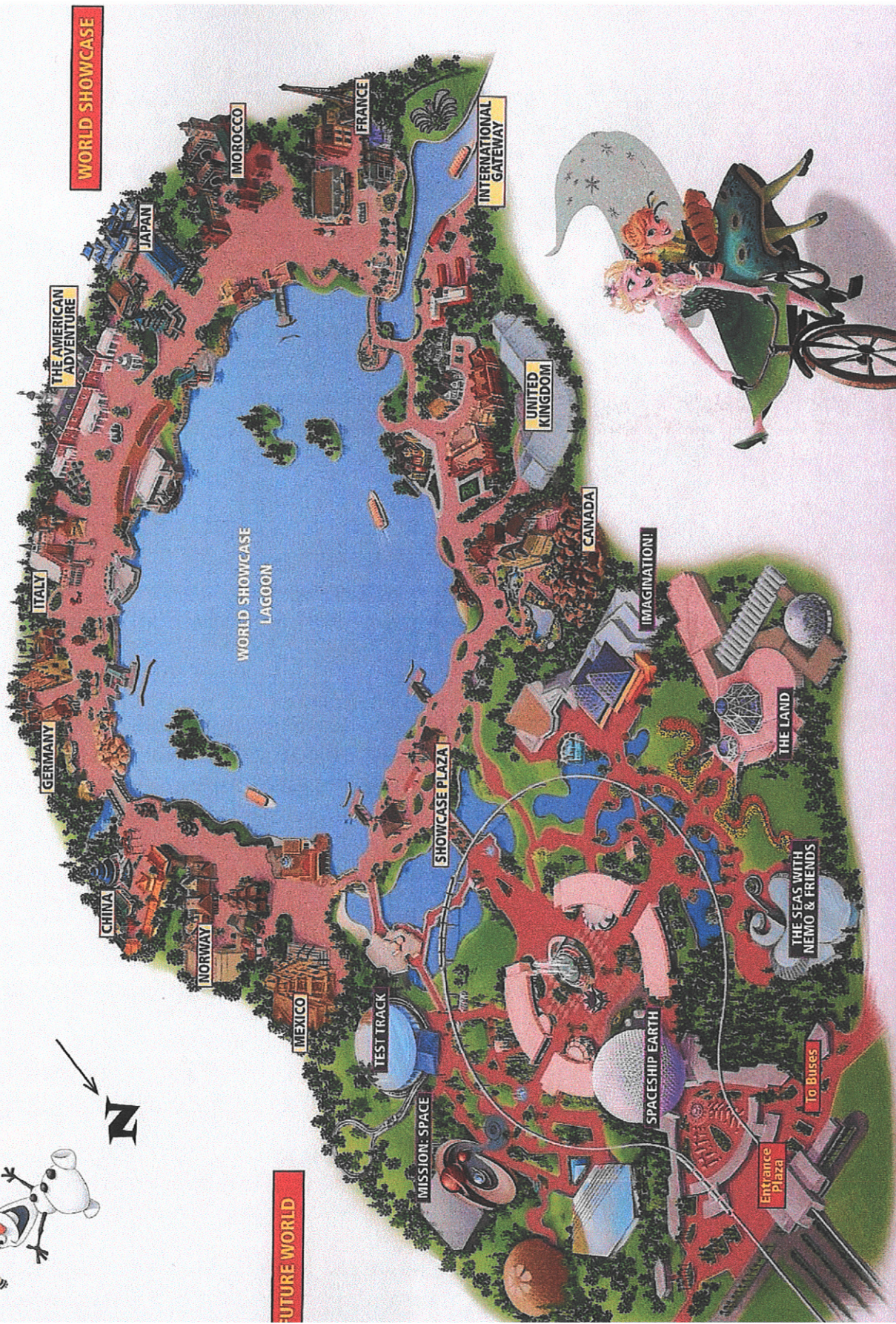
DINOLAND U. S. A.

CHESTER & HESTER'S DINO-RAMA. A colorful land within a land, Chester & Hester's is an area ideally suited for old fashioned midway games and 2 rides, **Primeval Whirl** and **Tricera Top Spin.**

DINOSAUR—This dizzying adventure begins with guests being strapped into vehicles and catapulted back in time to complete a dangerous, noble, mission: to rescue the last iguanodon, a 16-foot plant-eating dinosaur and bring him back to the present. This 3 1/2 minute attraction offers more than a thrill a minute. You rocket through time, are practically pelted by meteors, and narrowly escape becoming a dino dinner as the carnotaurus suddenly turns the tables and chases after you!!

FINDIN NEMO-THE MUSICAL, catch this 40 minute performance at the enclosed and air conditioned Theater in the Wild.

FUTURE WORLD

Epcot

EPCOT (EXPERIMENTAL PROTOTYPE COMMUNITY OF TOMORROW)

EPCOT is more than twice the size of the magic Kingdom and visitors must be prepared to do a certain amount of walking and standing in line. Unlike the Magic Kingdom where the rides create a feeling of fantasy or adventure, EPCOT rides and attractions lean toward a futuristic look at the world, providing visitors education as well as entertainment. **EPCOT is divided into two main sections, Future World and World Showcase. Future World opens at 9:00 a.m. and World Showcase opens at 11:00.** (TIP: Epcot is bigger than it seems, so allow plenty of time to get from place to place, it takes about 30 minutes to walk from Spaceship Earth to Japan.)

WORLD SHOWCASE

World Showcase is an ongoing world's fair representing a dozen countries situated around the 40 acre World Showcase Lagoon. Each country has a pavilion displaying its culture, history, and architecture. The pavilions consist of typical landmarks and street scenes of each particular country and the people working in the shops and restaurants are native to that country. It is the closest you can get to visiting a foreign country without leaving the U.S.

Norway--Be sure to ride the Maelstrom boat ride located in the Norwegian village. Passengers board a dragon-headed longboat that takes them through a forest populated by trolls. Special Note: as you are waiting to board your Viking ship be sure to notice the Viking mural painted on the wall. Instead of a helmet with horns, one Viking is wearing mouse ears.

Mexico--enter the pre-Columbian pyramid and take a boat trip on the River of Time. Say "**Hola!**" to **Donald Duck** as you explore the base of an Aztec pyramid.

China--one of the most beautiful pavilions. Circle-Vision 360 movie provides a wonderful look at this little known land and its people. **In the shadow of the Temple of Heaven can be found a heroine who brought honor to us all, meet Mulan.**

Germany--different German shops and beautiful old world structures. **A wishing well on the outskirts of this charming hamlet is a favorite spot of the fairest one of all, meet Snow White.**

Italy--Different shops. **Laugh with master juggler and mime Sergio as he engages you in a lighthearted, old Italian piazza-style juggling show.**

Japan--Pretty gardens and a Samurai Castle.

Morocco--Has a street bazaar, narrow streets, but no Rick's Café. **Pay a visit to Princess Jasmine and Aladdin in a lively Moroccan marketplace near Restaurant Marrakesh.**

France--See the Eiffel Tower, sidewalk cafe, real french pastry (good) See Impressions of France movie, another good place to sit down and relax. **Meet Belle from Disney's *Beauty and the Beast* on an adventure in the great wide somewhere. A regal gazebo in this beautifully manicured garden provides the perfect setting to greet Princess Aurora.**

United Kingdom--Different shops that have great souvenirs that you can only get in the United Kingdom or at Epcot!! **Meet Winnie the Pooh and Friends from the Hundred Acre Wood come to life in Christopher Robin's room. Also see and meet Mary Poppins.**

Canada—The U.S.A.'s neighbor to the North has a good Circle-Vision movie, O Canada.

United States--Attendance at the American Adventure is the one of the requirements for EPCOT! (We will have a test later). Another good place to beat the heat and enjoy an excellent audio-animatronics presentation. The Disney people went all out on this 29 minute presentation of American History. **You will also find one of the few fast food restaurants in EPCOT next door, called the LIBERTY INN.**

FUTURE WORLD

SPACESHIP EARTH--This is the symbol of EPCOT (the giant golf ball) Ride back in time and learn about the history of communication. This is not to be missed. This is the first thing you come to so the lines may be long in the morning. I would do this a little later and head to the LAND and get in line for **SOARIN'**! Soarin' is a must ride for everyone, a relaxing ride on a hang glider, 45 feet in the air over a giant IMAX projection dome.

INNOVENTIONS EAST & WEST--Imagine being able to get your hands on technological goodies fresh off the drawing board, gadgets that will one day change the way you live and work. At Innoventions, you can see, touch, and test products. Innoventions East contains the exhibits by Honeywell, Motorola, GE, Family PC, and General Motors. Innoventions West contains exhibits by Sega, AT&T, IBM, and Silicon Graphics.

UNIVERSE OF ENERGY--Learn about the different kinds of energy. Dinosaurs are the highlight here. As home to a 45 minute attraction, the Universe of Energy is a great place to take a load off your feet and give your body a chance to cool off. Just be sure to take a bathroom break first. There is a 38 minute stretch in a ride vehicle and no opportunity for a pit stop.

MISSION: SPACE--Think you've got the right stuff? Well, this is your chance to prove it. Epcot's out-of-this-world attraction has a bold mission—to give you a chance to feel the excitement and extreme intensity of space travel without ever leaving the planet. The original attraction can wreak havoc on the equilibrium. To cut the chances of losing your lunch, keep your eyes open at all times and fixed on the screen in front of you. You may be tempted to tilt your head or shut your eyes. Don't!!!! There are actually two ways to travel to Mars at this attraction: the "highly intense" way (aka the Orange team) and the "less intense" experience (the Green team, especially if you don't like to spin!). The sustained G-force during lift off is intended to be most realistic. (Don't eat before riding!)

TEST TRACK-- This new General Motors pavilion was among the most keenly anticipated in Epcot history. Fasten your seat belt! It is a thrill ride of the highest order, and keeping with the park's mission to educate as well as entertain. It also happens to be one of the fastest rides in Disney history. You can design your own race car and then give it a test drive!

THE LAND—Occupying six acres, this enormous skylighted pavilion examines the nature of one of everybody's favorite topics—food. Very educational about our environment. This is a great place to use your Meal Ticket! **THE CIRCLE OF LIFE:** A 20 minute film uses animation and live action to illustrate some of the dangers of our environment featuring several characters from *The Lion King*.

SOARIN': Up, Up and Away! On this high-flying Epcot attraction (one of the most popular attractions at Walt Disney World). You'll be suspended in a hang glider 45 feet in the air, above a giant IMAX projection dome, and treated to an aerial tour of some of the most awe-inspiring landscapes the state of California has to offer. **Highly recommended to the Vandal Band!!! This ride is very popular and stays crowded all day but plan ahead and ride it!!**

THE SEAS WITH NEMO & FRIENDS—The largest facility ever dedicated to humanity's relationship with the ocean. Visit the Caribbean Coral Reef and Sea Base Alpha. This pavilion used to be called the **Living Seas** but thanks to a little clownfish named *Nemo* and some of his fishy friends has been changed!

JOURNEY INTO IMAGINATION--Ride along with Dreamfinder and Figment and discover your imagination. Also, a great movie to see is a spectacular 3-D Captain EO starring Michael Jackson.

EATING AT EPCOT

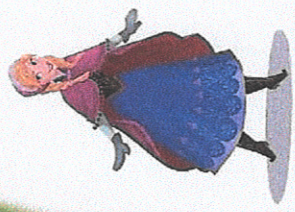
There are not that many fast food places in EPCOT as there were in the magic Kingdom. There is the Liberty Inn next to the American Adventure in World Showcase and in Future World there is the Sunrise Terrace in INNOVENTIONS WEST, and the Stargate Restaurant in INNOVENTIONS EAST, and these are really good. There are a lot of expensive restaurants in the different countries that are really good but expensive. Some you have to have reservations. These are neat if you want to pay for it.

- Lines throughout Epcot are longest at midday and shortest in the early evening.
- Most World Showcase restaurants seat guest until park closes but require reservations and are usually expensive. Reservations need to be made as early as possible, can be made days in advance as well.

As you enter the front gate you will find yourself on Hollywood Boulevard of the 30's and 40's. There are a lot of Unique Shops here but make your way on to Sunset Boulevard and turn right and get ready to party!!

TWILIGHT ZONE TOWER OF TERROR

Behold the mysterious Hollywood Tower Hotel, a relic of Tinseltown's golden age. Even before you enter the lobby of the abandoned hotel, there are signs of impending danger high on the side of the 199-ft tall building; a sparking electrical sign hangs above the gaping hole in the tower walls. Legend has it that an entire guest wing was once attached to that damaged wall. What happened to the wing, and more important, what happened to the people in the tower when it disappeared? Not to be missed! **Be sure to look at your picture as you leave!!!**

BEAUTY AND THE BEAST LIVE ON STAGE

Very entertaining musical in the 1500 seat Theatre of the Stars amphitheater on Sunset Boulevard. The 30 minute show is as entertaining as they come. Watch for performance times.

ROCK 'n' ROLLER COASTER starring Aerosmith

The newest and fastest roller coaster in Disney history is guaranteed to rock your world. The indoor attraction reaches a speed of 60 miles per hour, in 2.8 seconds flat. The ride's premise is this: A chart-topping band has invited you to a backstage party. The only thing standing between you and the big bash is...the Los Angeles Freeway--at rush hour, not to mention the two loops and a corkscrew!!!!

LIGHTNING McQUEEN'S RACING ACADEMY

The approximately 10-minute show is most popular with young Cars fans.

THE MAGIC OF ANIMATION

Tour gives guests an insider look at the creative process behind Disney's many animated blockbusters. You get to see how the animation is done and watch the animators at work.

THE VOYAGE OF THE LITTLE MERMAID

A 17 minute musical production, adapted from the Disney animated Classic. Watch for scheduled times throughout the day.

THE GREAT MOVIE RIDE (now called Mickey & Minnie's Runaway Railway)

This is in the Chinese Theater which is located at the center of the park at the end of Hollywood Boulevard. Visitors board a ride which takes them through famous scenes from Hollywood movies. It takes about 25 minutes to board the ride once you enter the theater. This is a very relaxing ride, good time to cool off and relax!

INDIANA JONES STUNT SPECTACULAR

A 2,000 seat amphitheater is the site for a daring stunt show that recreates some of the most exciting scenes from "Raiders of the Lost Ark". The dialogue is corny, but the stunts are really good. You get to see how props are moved and how stunts are done with great care and safety. You can even volunteer to be one of the actors in the show!

STAR TOURS—THE ADVENTURES CONTINUE

Inspired by George Lucas' block buster series of Star Wars films, this opened in 1989 and is better than ever. A new Star Wars experience touched down in 2011, complete with a new story line. This 3-D experience offers guests the opportunity to ride on StarSpeeders, the exact same type of flight simulator used by the military and commercial airlines to train pilots. A galaxy of trouble awaits Jedi wannabes, but fear not, the FORCE will be with you. This is a turbulent trip, seat belts are a definite requirement. Passengers must be free of back problems, heart conditions, motion sickness and other physical limitations to ride.

STAR WARS LAUNCH BAY

Explore immersive exhibits and get a peek behind the scenes of the new movie, *Star Wars: The Last Jedi*. This is your chance to discover sights, sounds and surprises that are sure to delight any *Star Wars* fan! As you journey through curated galleries, receive an up-close look at costumes, models, concept artwork and actual props borrowed from Lucasfilm—as well as authentic replicas created specifically for *Star Wars* Launch Bay.

Check out a newly updated and exclusive documentary on the creative team behind this ever-evolving cultural phenomenon. Wander around a Cantina and other settings inspired by the films, then share a furry embrace with Chewbacca, Han Solo's trusty sidekick. Brave fans may even come face-to-face with the imposing First Order warrior Kylo Ren!

FANTASMIC!

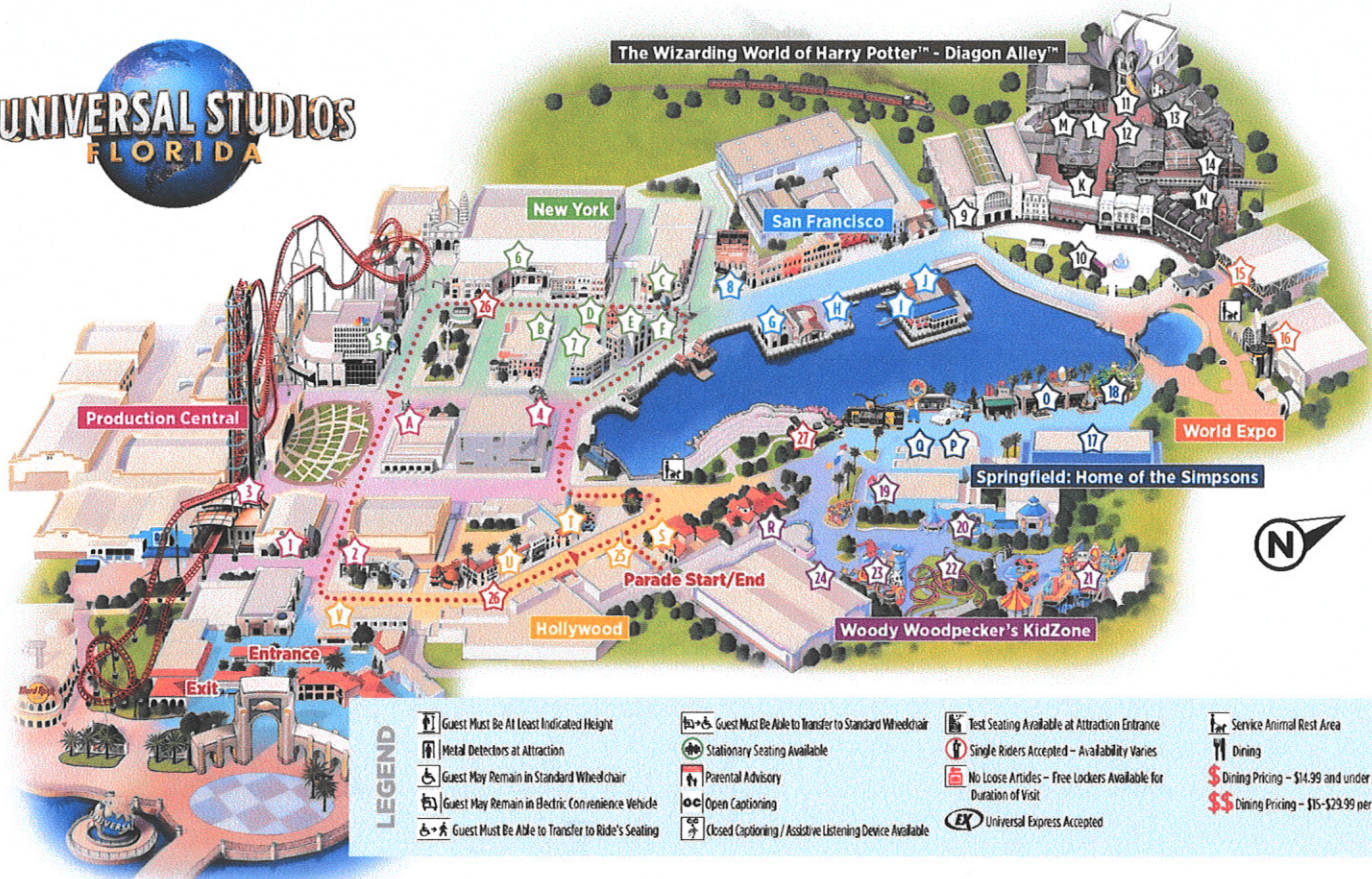
